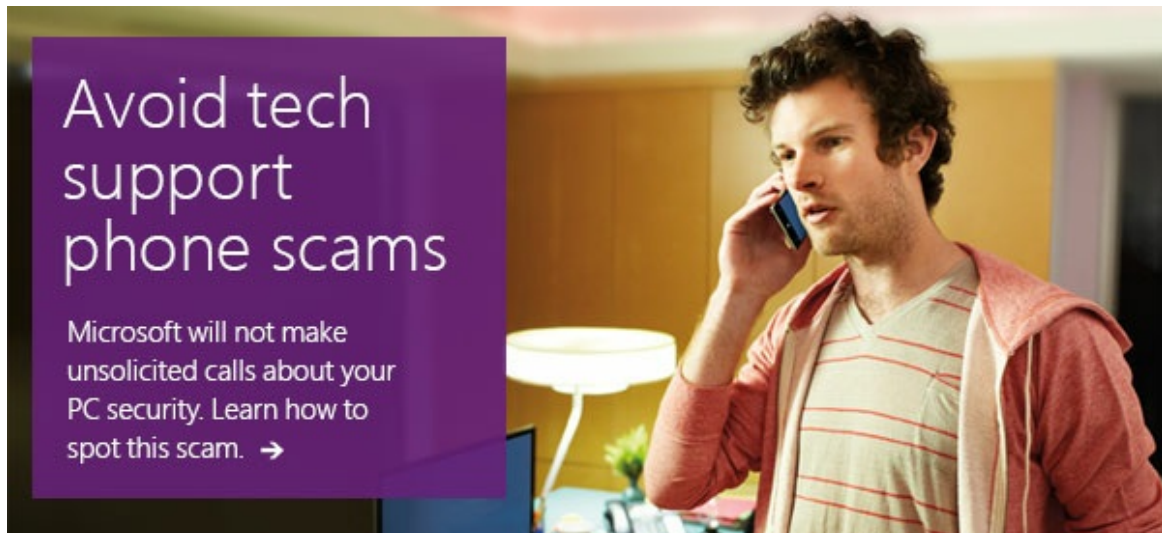


Beware of Fake Tech Support Phone Calls

They are very cunning sometimes working remotely on your computer for hours without asking for payment. What they are trying to do is build trust with you so the next time they call you will be more likely to go along with what they suggest.
