

Picasa Video Lessons

Since I accumulate so many photos this time of year I thought it would be a good time to learn more about Picasa, the free photo organizer and image editor from Google. It is available for download for both [Windows](#) and [Intel Macs](#) if it is not already installed on your computer.



This month I am introducing my new online video lessons. In these videos you will be able to see my computer screen and hear my voice as I demonstrate specific features of the Picasa program. These are short lessons, under 5 minutes, designed to introduce you to a new feature. Feel free to experiment in Picasa because the program never touches your original photo that came from your camera. You can always undo any changes that you make to a photo. So feel free to experiment and have fun sharing all those great shots with family and fiends.
