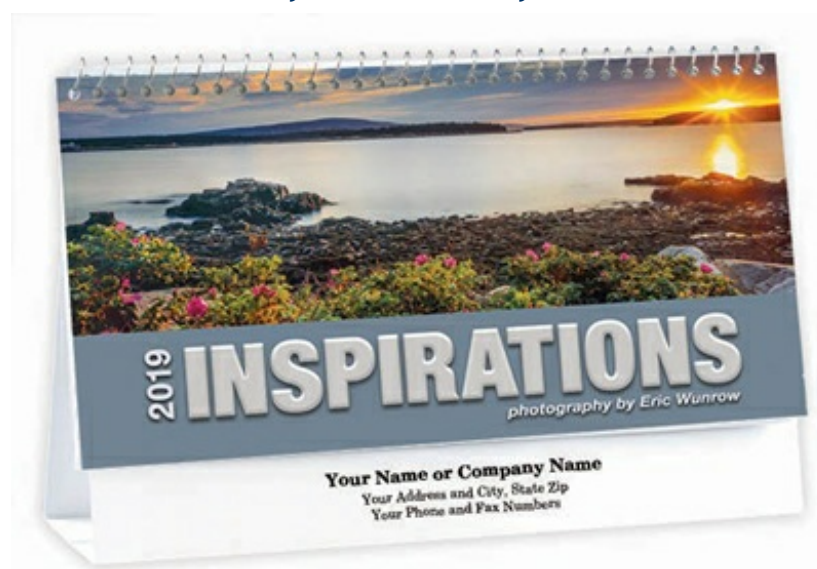

## Dark Web

The Internet is much bigger than any of us realize. We all know about Amazon.com, Google.com, and so on, but what about encrypted websites that you can't get to with a normal browser? This is called the [Dark Web](#) which hosts services such as Botnets, Bitcoin services, Darknet markets, Hacking groups and services, Fraud services, Hoaxes and unverified content, Phishing and scams, Puzzles, Illegal pornography, Terrorism, Social media.

When there is a data breach at *USPS* and *Marriott* for example, our personal information can end up on the Dark Web. *Dashlane*, among others, [offers to scan the Dark Web](#) to see if our information is out there. Basically, *Dashlane* uses your email address to see if any data breaches have taken place with that email address and suggests you change your password on the breached websites. So the next time you hear about a data breach simply change your password on that website and any other website that uses the same password. Besides this, and [freezing your credit file](#), there is not much that we can do when another data breach occurs.

## Dashlane VPN

*Dashlane* now has VPN service along with its password manager service. When you are away from home connected to WiFi it is good practice to use a VPN service to hide your activity. *Dashlane's* VPN service is very easy to use.
