

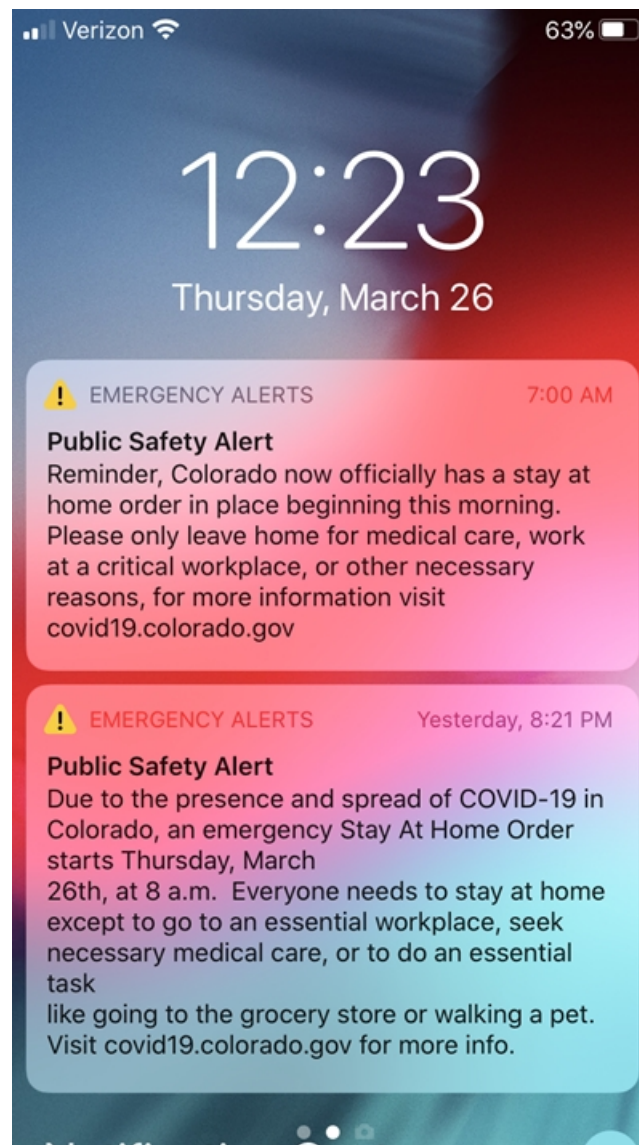

Emergency & Public Safety Alerts



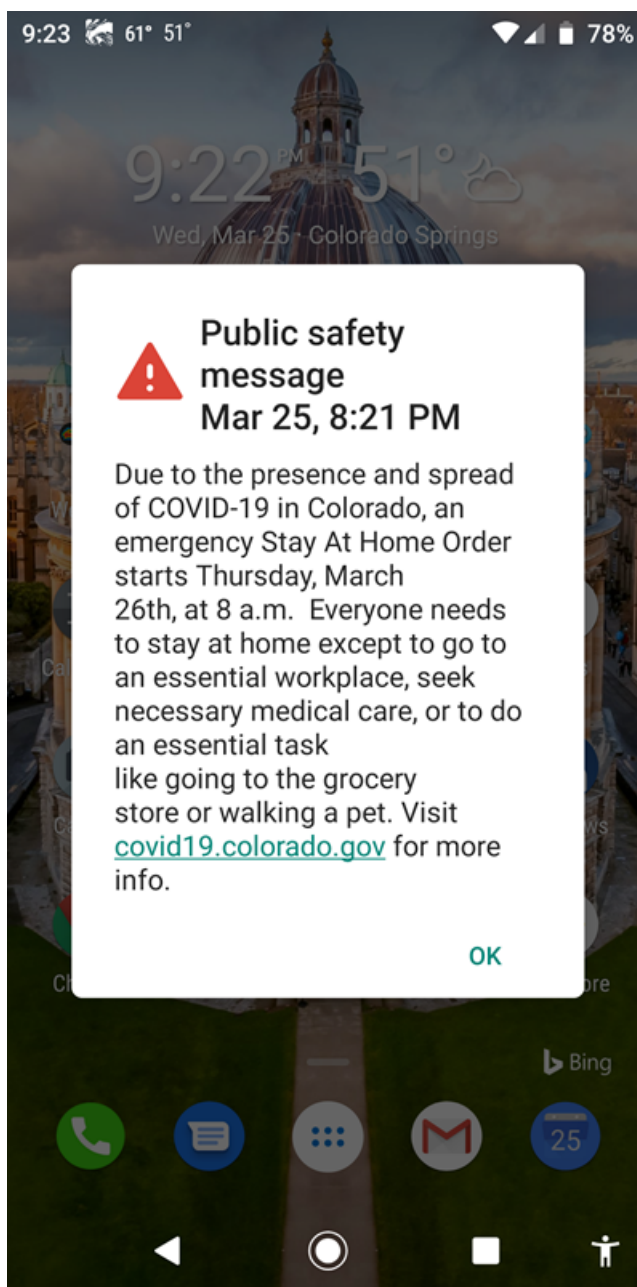
iPhone Alerts

I received a "Public Safety Alert" on my cell phone last night and again this morning and it got me thinking, "I hope everyone has this feature turned on". From time-to-time we all get these alerts for:

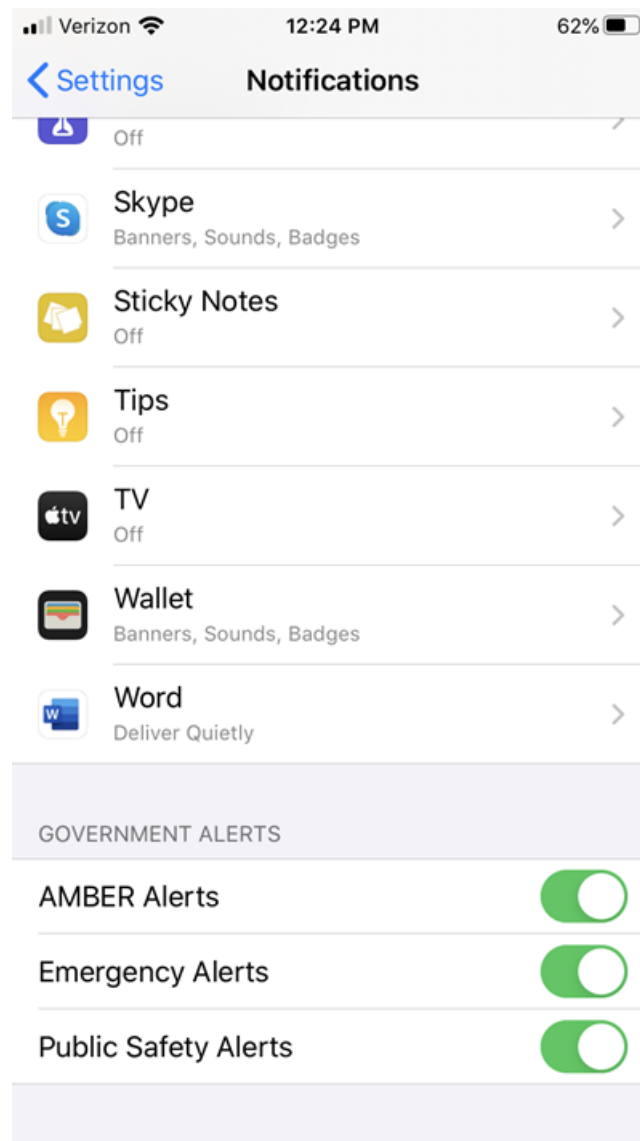

If you need to turn on these alerts or just want to double check the settings, here are the steps for the latest iOS (if you are using an older iPhone, your steps might be slightly different):

1. On your iPhone touch "Settings" (Tip: If you cannot find Settings slide your finger down the screen, from the middle of the screen, to bring up the search screen. You might find it right on this screen, or you might need to type "Settings" to bring it up.)
2. Touch "Notifications"

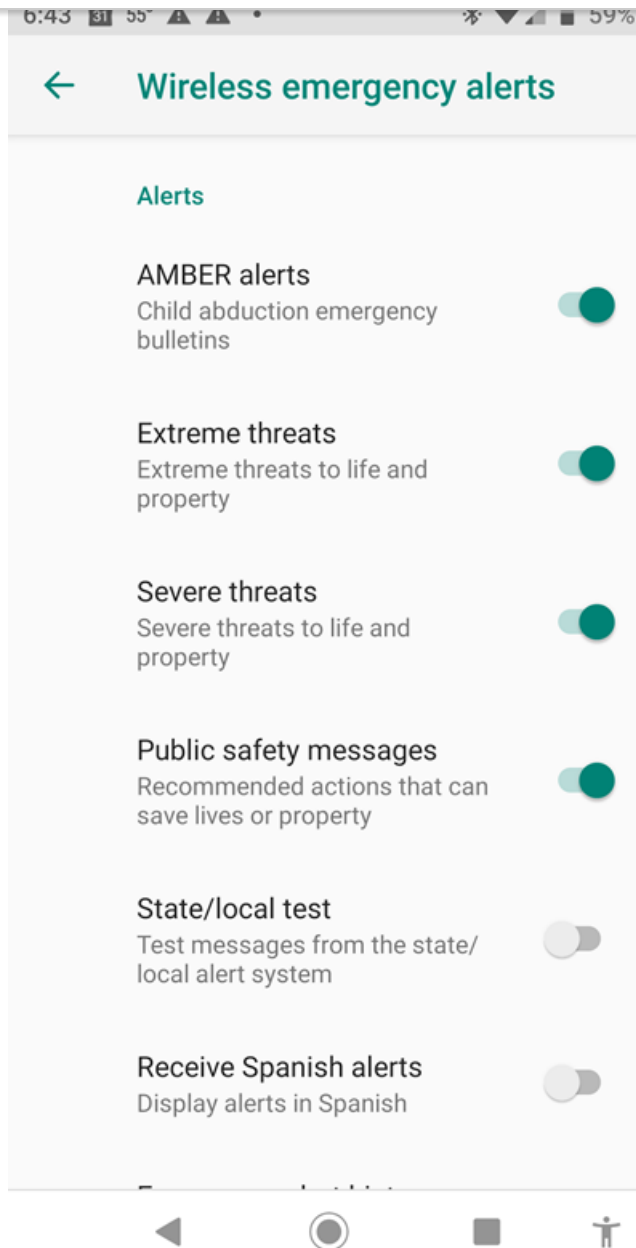

Android Phones

To check the settings on an Android cell phone, here are the steps (Note: There are many different versions of Android from many different manufacturers, so your steps might be different.):

1. On your Android phone go to "Settings" (Tip: If you cannot find Settings slide your finger down the screen, from the middle of the screen, to bring up the search screen. You might find it right on this screen, or you might need to type "Settings" to bring it up.)
2. Touch "Apps & Notifications"
3. Scroll all the way to the bottom of the page
4. Touch "Advanced"
5. Scroll down to "Wireless emergency alerts"
6. Make sure all the different kinds of alerts are turned on (slide to the right)
